Executive Summary

This analysis undertaken, by the Chair of Faculty Senate, reports the percentage of senate-related committee positions being served by *female professional and academic staff*. Thus, the computed percentages do not include students, non-voting MC or CSEA (except for the full faculty senate in which MC and CSEA are voting members). The gender by employee type data was provided by HR and the numbers reported include full-time employees only (the highlighted columns were computed by J. Ouellette).

<u>Gender by Employee Type:</u> The gender breakdown of employees is about the same for academic and professional faculty; approximately 54% of the academic faculty is female (46% male) while approximately 53% of the professional faculty are female (47% male). Thus, females account for a slightly higher proportion of this workforce.

<u>Faculty Senate Steering Committee</u>: made of up the 4 senate officers and 4 policy chairs, this committee is **87.50%** female (7/8 members are female) and it should be noted that **all senate officers are female**. There are 10 major policy or curricular committees of the senate (including GFEC); for the purposes of this analysis only nine chairs will be considered because the COC is currently chaired by the head of HR (an MC); of the remaining nine committees eight (**88.89%**) **are chaired by women**. When considering the <u>membership</u> of all 10 committees, **60%** of the committees (6/10) **are staffed by 65% or more female members** (CCRC, COC, CRC, CTE, EPC, and GE). Only one committee (AFAC) is staffed primarily by males (83.33%), while the remaining three committees (GFEC, PAC, and SAC) are staffed with 50% female and 50% male membership.

<u>Academic Grievance Tribunal</u> –there are six faculty positions on AGT that are senate-elected, of these 6 members, **4 are female** (66.67%). The chair of AGT is male.

Senators of Faculty Senate: 14 of the 26 non-officer seats of senate of staffed by females (53.84%).

<u>Single position seats on other committees</u>: there are four single positon senate-related seats on other committees; these four seats are staffed equally by female and male members.

<u>Conclusion</u>: Despite the fact that average percent of female academic and professional staff workforce is only slightly greater than their male counterparts (53.5% vs. 46.5%)–it appears that the female academic and professional faculty *disproportionally account* for the staffing of the major committees of senate. This finding is consistent with recent published research.² Importantly, many of these committees are responsible for major academic policy and curricular decisions on campus and their workload each year can be quite heavy (CCRC, EPC, CTE, GE, and GFEC). Of great concern is the extent to which service is valued (or not) in personnel decisions (renewal, continuing appointment, and promotion); if the typical practice at Cortland is to weigh service activities less than teaching and scholarship/creative activities when making personnel decisions, than the current data would suggest that the committee work that women are providing may be *undervalued* and could lead to differential personnel actions compared to their male counterparts. For the benefit of all campus members, the senate chair verbally requested that the administration formally state, in writing, the proportion of time that they expect faculty to engage in service, teaching, and scholarship/creative activities (3/6/18 steering committee meeting). By doing so, all members of the campus community can make informed decisions about how to best allocate their time toward fulfill their responsibilities.
