Prepare for advising and registration for summer and fall 2024 classes.

If you have not yet heard from your academic advisor about available advising appointments, check to see if they use [Starfish](#) for setting up the appointments. If not, reach out to them via email.

Course Schedule

Be sure to check out the [course schedule](#) to see what classes are being offered and when. Make your appointment with your academic advisor well before your time ticket so you can register on time. You will need a PIN to register.

Check Registration Status

You can look up your “time ticket” (when you can begin to register) in myRedDragon under the “Student” tab, left column and “Prepare for Registration”. Your time ticket is based on how many credit hours you have earned. This does not include how many credit hours you are currently taking. Registration begins for the following students:

Graduate students: April 1	Seniors: April 2	Juniors: April 4
Sophomores: April 8	Freshmen: April 11	

Web registration stays open through drop/add of the fall semester. You should also see if you have any holds as that will prevent you from registering.
