### Introduction

After several years of consideration, SUNY Cortland Career Services opted to collect the class of 2023\* first destinations and graduate outcomes survey data using the Handshake digital career platform. Handshake's first destinations tool better aligns the SUNY Cortland outcomes with national first destinations standards both in timing of data collection and in use of the standard first destination survey established by the National Association for Colleges and Employers (NACE). The NACE survey is slightly different than the survey SUNY Cortland has used in the past. Perhaps the biggest change is that this survey only tracks students' primary outcomes following graduation (either employment or graduate school, etc.). At the time of implementation, the Handshake tool did not allow the College to collect information on students' dual pursuits, therefore this report does not include information on dual pursuits, nor will the 2024 cohort report. Fortunately, updates to Handshake's system will allow us to collect dual pursuit information for the 2025 cohort. Despite the loss of dual pursuit data for the 2023 cohort, the number of graduates that indicated they were continuing education or working remains consistent with previous years' reports. Data for this cohort was collected at earlier timeframes to increase our knowledge rate. For example, May 2023 graduates received their survey prior to graduation. As a result, data collection happened over a longer time period. We are pleased to report that we have increased our overall undergraduate knowledge rate for the 2023 cohort to 65%. The graduate cohort knowledge rate, typically much lower than the undergraduate rate, increased from 36 to 42%.

The Handshake first destination survey does not collect information on whether students are working in a field related to their major. Instead, the survey asks graduates to identify their employer's industry and their job function. This information better aligns with career coaching best practices that focus on helping students build transferable skills, or NACE competencies, required for every career. Interestingly, 28% of students working (n=131) were employed in education/teaching/training job functions. While many of these students graduated from educator preparation programs at SUNY Cortland, many graduates from non-education majors also reported this job function. These students were employed in a variety of industries including but not limited to K-12 education, social assistance, higher education, and healthcare. As the world of work continues to evolve, the job function data highlights the importance of incorporating career design and competency development into the curriculum across all majors.

Overall, the class of 2023\* is entering the workforce as many of the negative impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic on the labor market have drastically decreased. Career Services continues to provide valuable programming and advising to students to aid students in building a bridge between their education and their career paths. Skill development is a vital tool for students to be able to transition between employment opportunities while building their career. As terms of employment shorten for our graduates, SUNY Cortland must continue to educate students on developing their transferable skills within all disciplines as part of career and self-development.

Thank you to our faculty and staff for all the big and small ways you help our students and alumni to find not only jobs or successfully graduate from programs, but to also find meaning and purpose in life. Your work matters for our students and alumni.










