If You Already Have a Plan

- 1. Review the campus strategic framework. Identify:
 - Activities in your plan that contribute to the campus priorities.
 - Activities you might want to add or move up in priority in light of the campus priorities.
 - Initiatives that might present collaborative opportunities.
 - Activities in your plan that you might want to stop doing or reduce in priority.
 - Update your plan, if needed.
- 2. Complete the attached matrix to illustrate alignment between your plan and the campus priorities.

♦ If You Are Developing a New Plan

- 1. Review the Campus Strategic Framework. Identify those things that align with important issues for your unit.
- 2. Your unit will have specific/unique issues to address. Identify those.
- 3. Develop your plan. Consider using a similar framework to the campus plan, if useful.
- 4. Complete the attached matrix to illustrate alignment between your plan and the campus priorities.
