

## **University of Wisconsin-Madison Project Management Framework**



## **Notes and Considerations:**

- This process was developed for single, internal projects. It is not specific to project type or industry. It is intended to be adapted to project scope and size, as well as an organization's culture. Even though process steps appear linear, they may in fact be interactive or iterative in nature.
- Circles imply involvement from different sources. An asterisk (\*) denotes customer involvement.
- "Full Team" includes subcontractors.
- "Project Plan" encompasses the project schedule and subordinate plans (e.g., communications, risk, etc.).
