For scheduling of days/times for Early Field Experiences (EFE)

Your course instructor may ask you to use this calendar, in collaboration with your Mentor Teacher (MT), to schedule your early field visits.

Reminder - all EFE log hours must be logged in Watermark and electronically approved by MT.

- ✓ The total amount of time scheduled should meet or exceed the minimum number of hours required for the course requirements.
- \checkmark You are expected to be in your placement throughout the entire semester.
- ✓ Provide your signature and obtain the MT's signature.
- ✓ Make three copies; keep one, give one to your MT, and submit one copy to your course instructor, if required.

If for any reason you are not able to be on time, or in attendance as indicated, you must notify your course instructor by email, in addition to notifying your MT (method of communicationg absences to be determined with MT - i.e. text, phone, and/or email).
